Highlights of 2019/2020

年青工程師高端創新科技 x 藝術文化考察團 2019

隨著粵港澳大灣區的發展愈趨成熟，青年會員事務委員會與常青匯友 (Forever Young Alumni) 於 2019 年 8 月 30 至 31 日合辦考察團，以了解香港與大灣區工程界的最新發展。我們亦有幸邀請到立法會工程界功能界別議員盧偉國博士、工程師作隨團顧問。



考察團先到香港科學園參觀，以加深團員對港深創新及科技園初步發展計劃的認識。在現時的規劃中，港深創新及科技園的可建樓面除了會用作高等教育及研究外，亦會預留部分作創新科技及文化創意展示等用途。隨後考察團到訪深圳的金茂大廈，進一步了解深圳市配合港深創新及科技園建設配套政策，同時俯瞰落馬洲河套區。

離開深圳市後，團員再到東莞市參觀，見證該市為配合粵港澳大灣區規劃而發展的部分重點項目。第一站是中國散裂中子源，它是世界第四及全國首個散裂中子源。散裂中子源是一個基於粒子加速器的

中子源，是用來探測物質微觀結構和運動的科研裝置。它可被應用於不同領域，包括材料科學、生命科學、醫藥等。中國散裂中子源現時也有與香港的科研機構合作。考察團在東莞的第二站是松山湖國際機器人產業基地，團員與發展無人機、運動控制、工業機器、自動化等高技術的企業進行交流，了解東莞市於機器人與信息技術領域的發展。

兩日一夜的考察團以東莞新地標燕嶺園作終點。透過參觀燕嶺園，公眾能了解和感受此中港兩地創意文化交流的新據點。是次考察團令團員對粵港澳大灣區，特別是工程界別的進程，有更深的了解。

To gain a broader insight into the engineering profession and foster warm relationships with engineering institutions from different regions, five young engineers attended the 37th Conference of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Federation of Engineering Organisations in conjunction with the 26th Meeting of Young Engineers of the ASEAN Federation of Engineering Organisations (YEAFEO) in Jakarta from 10 - 13 September 2019.

Under the theme of "The beacon of sustainable development", the conference discussed pertinent

issues and trends in connectivity, equitability and prosperity.

One of the highlights was the country report session. In this session, our delegates explained how Hong Kong's connectivity was enhanced through meticulous transport planning, and how the city reduced flood risks by embracing the concept of blue-green infrastructure and building sustainable drainage systems.



The delegates were also invited to attend the YEAFEO Governing Board Meeting to contribute ideas to the amendment of the YEAFEO regulation, a review of the YEAFEO registration fees and other institutional matters.

Apart from the seminars and meetings, the delegates were able to appreciate the engineering developments in Jakarta through various technical visits. They went to the Headquarters of the Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) in Jakarta to investigate the design and construction of the newly opened MRT line, which has resolved much of the traffic congestion in the city.

They witnessed the application of 'Sosrobahu' technology at a bridge construction site, which reduced road closures by allowing pier heads to be constructed parallel to the existing road before being lifted by oil-filled hydraulic jacks and rotated in place.



They also visited the Menara Astra tower and saw the environmentally sustainable design features and a technology company Gojek that provides multi-services and digital payment solutions to customers, drivers and merchants in Southeast Asia.

The delegates were also honoured to meet Mr Anies Baswedan, the Governor of Jakarta, in a banquet and exchange ideas with Dr Basuki Hadimuljono, the Minister of Public Works and Housing, on lean construction and green building. They were also able to develop new friendship with delegates from different regions and discussed collaboration in the future.

The four-day event was a great opportunity to widen the young engineers' horizons and extend the YMC's network. We look forward to the next conference in Vietnam.



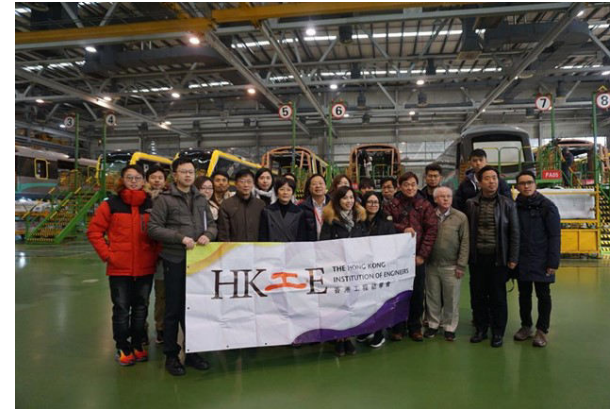


湖南省工程文化考察團

內地改革開放後發展迅速，青年會員事務委員會多年來積極舉辦內地考察團，以助年青工程師拓闊視野，增進交流。本年，青委會以「鐵路・水資源・歷史・文化」為考察綱領，選址湖南，於 2019 年 12 月 21 日起進行了九天的考察。

湖南省位於長江中游、洞庭湖南岸，並有湘江貫穿全境。百姓靠水吃水，水資源的運用以及河洪防治成為湖南的千古課題。在衡山上，團員步進禹王城，回味昔日大禹眺望湘江，思慮治水良策。現今，湖南省的水利戰略規劃以及水資源的開發由水利廳負責。在與他們的交流中，團員充分感受到他們出色的防洪聯線和打造「海綿城市」的積極；政府亦隨著氣候變化及對可持續發展的重視，建造節水型社會。

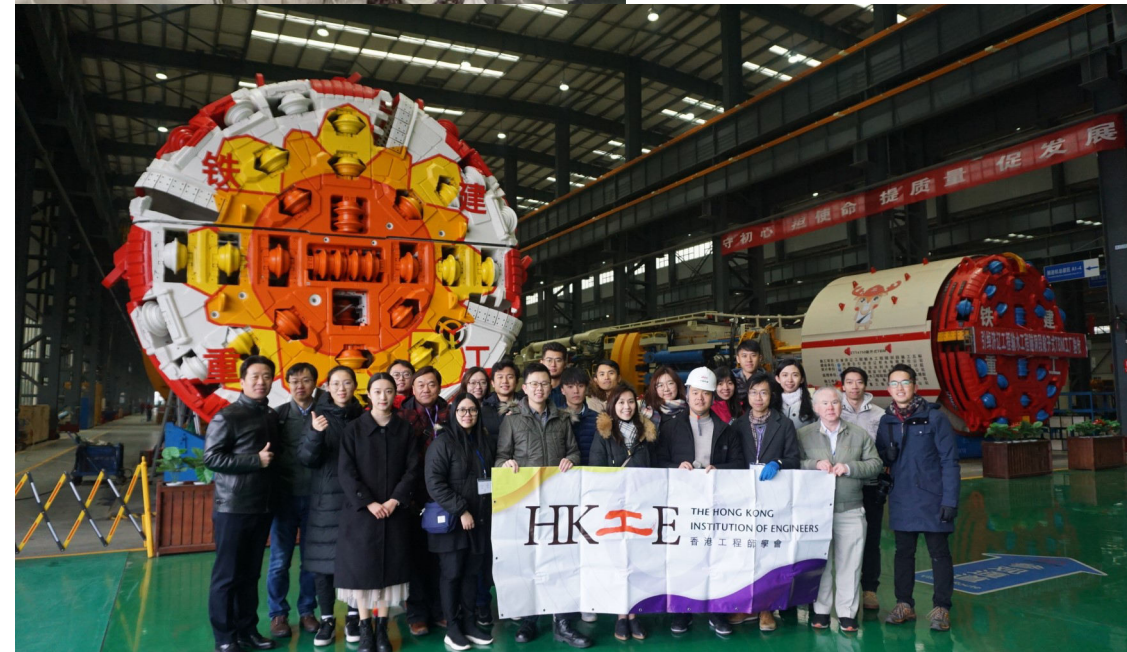
湖南的鐵路產業現今蜚聲國際。參訪中車株洲的時候，職員為我們介紹了 80



年間，他們從仰人鼻息地倚靠蘇俄技術到現在列車反銷國外的歷程。為體驗最新磁浮列車的普及應用，團員於長沙磁浮快線乘坐他們自主研發的「追風者」號，感受其穩定和寧靜。此外，團員亦有幸參觀了負責製造隧道工程裝備和鐵路軌道的中國鐵建以及實現 L4 級自動駕駛的湘江新區智能系統測試區。

湖南有着濃厚的歷史文化背景，當地的土家族人仍流傳着先祖蚩尤的事蹟。族人於團中熱心地講解他們獨特的哭嫁、趕屍及梯瑪文化。在洞庭湖上，團員到了五帝之中，虞帝二妃之墓；亦登上了岳陽樓，體現古人「先天下之憂而憂」的家國情懷。

團友們在旅程中都非常投入，每有所得便熱切討論。藉此感謝各接待單位的鼎力支持，令是次考察團得以圓滿成功。
