Entry Requirements:

Award:

- The Committee reserves the right not to award the prize if there are insufficient entries.
- Only **One (1)** number of YMC Best Reporter Award (\$500) will be granted in each event organised by the HKIE-YMC.

Submission:

- The report shall be neatly typed and up to a maximum of 350 words, in a form suitable for direct publication in the HKIE Journal and in Microsoft Word format. Graphical or pictorial illustrations are recommended.
- Deadline of submission is 3-week from the date of event.
- The soft copy of the report should be submitted together with the HKIE Standard Reply Form. Participants should refer to the event organiser for submission details.

Terms and Conditions:

- Plagiarism is strictly not allowed. Participant with plagiarism report submission will be disqualified for the YMC Best Reporter Award in that event.
- HKIE-YMC reserves the right of final decision on awarding the YMC Best Reporter Award.

The Best Reporter will be informed within twelve weeks of the event.
